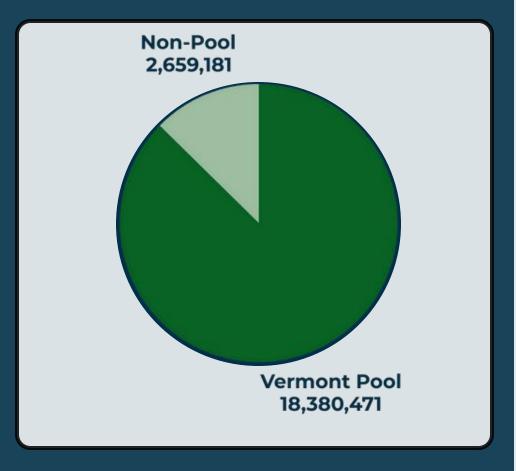

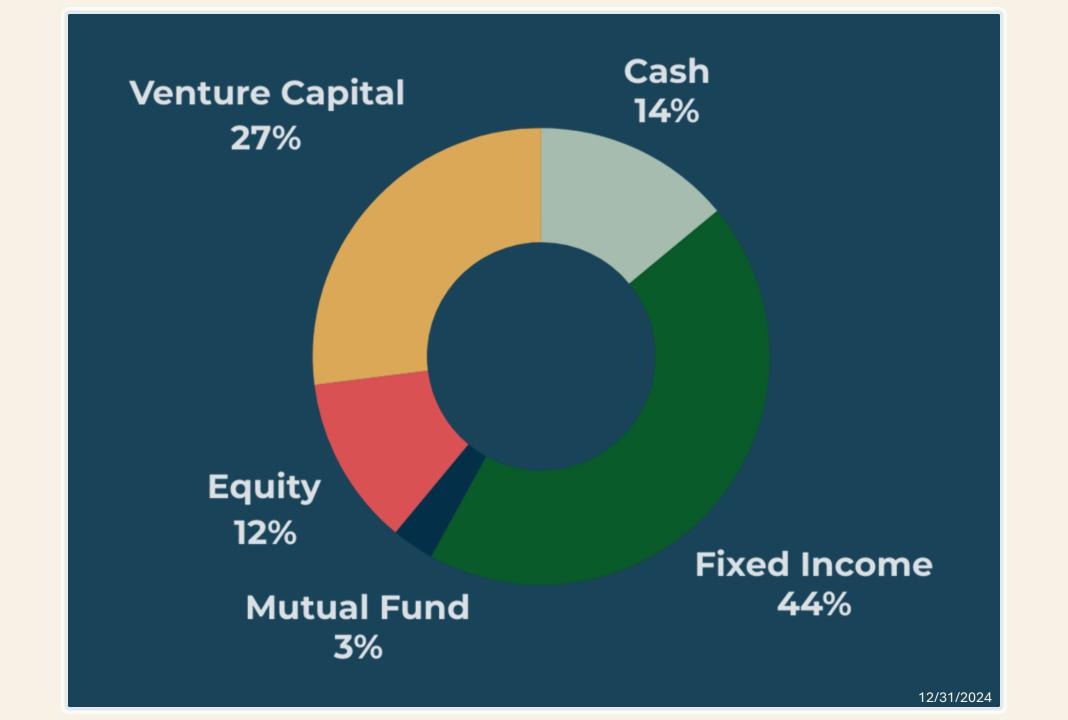
Vermont Pool

The Vermont Pool is 5% of the VCF total pooled assets intended for place based Vermont investments.

Non-Pool

Mission related investments including follow on investments with DAF partners and absorbed High Meadows and Taproot investments.







2024 Preliminary Financial Results*

Vermont Pool

Objective: over the long term maintain purchasing power net of losses, expenses, and inflation. Individual investment return targets are adjusted for both risk and social impact

- Beginning Balance \$16,991,230
- Ending Balance \$18,380,471
- New Contributions \$936,014
- Expenses \$129,965 = 0.71%
- Investment Gain (net of expenses) \$453,227 = 2.7%

Investment Focus – WheelPad L3C

- Located in Wilmington, Vermont
 - Windham County, Route 9 midway between Brattleboro and Bennington
 - Tourism and Hospitality Economic Area
- L3C = Low Profit Limited Liability Company
 - Form of legal business entity created for social enterprises to allow a board to prioritize mission over maximum profit
- Modular accessible units to augment any home
 - Driven by founders' personal experience
 - Affiliated non-profit for Low to Moderate Income subsidies
 - VCF Impact Areas: Economic Equity, Health and Wellbeing, Education and Training
- Five Year Working Capital Loan for Inventory (Fixed Income Investment)
 - Be able to meet immediate needs of users

Introducing WheelPad

Designs and manufacturers modular accessible homes that range from a 200 sq. ft. accessible bedroom and bathroom that can be **freestanding or attached** to an existing home, to a one bedroom backyard cottage with a kitchenette, or to a multi-unit accessible apartment building.

WheelPad Needs to be Ready When a Customer Needs Their Home Most

In 2020:

2. March 19: Permit process completed, no permit required.

4. March 27: Suite PAD lease signed

1. March 16, 2020:

2020 Frantic call from Bob, needs to bring Dad home.

3. March 21:

Dad out of Nursing Facility, into their dining room

5. April 4: SuitePAD delivered, connector started

6. April 10, 2020:

Connector completed





Now: Due to lack of inventory, for every one SuitePAD we've delivered, we've had to turn SIX customers away.
